IMPORTANT NOTE FROM CMLS

We are excited to announce that our Matrix system is now running in parallel with the RE/Xplorer and Paragon systems. Please keep in mind that our site is a work in progress- programmers are constantly working behind the scenes, fixing problems and adding/modifying features and functionality. So there may be times when the system appears to be slow or data from RE/Xplorer does not match up perfectly with what is showing in Matrix. These are temporary instances, and the majority of them should be behind us.

That being said, we encourage you to investigate all the functionality that is currently available, and hope that you will not be shy in reporting any issues/questions/suggestions you may have. There is a [MATRIX DISCUSSION PAGE](#) that allows you to post questions or issues so that all users can see it. You can also email us at matrix@ct-mls.com, or call the CMLS office and go to extension 330 for Matrix assistance.

Additionally, please be aware that listing input and modification will not be available until we completely cut over to Matrix in August. Until then, you will continue to input and modify your listings in RE/Xplorer.
