historian who garnered attention for his Pulitzer Prize-winning work. He died of a sudden stroke in 1986 in New York City.

Mr. White was best known for his analytical book series "The Making of the President," and he was the recipient of numerous journalism awards, including a 1962 Pulitzer and two Emmys for his television writing.

Meanwhile, his wife was a high-profile editor who was instrumental in helping him focus four of his books. Her daughter, Sarah Hofstadter, once called her mother "the writer behind the throne," and according to an obituary in The New York Times, she was "chagrined" to have made it so far but was thankful for having kept her mind sharp all the way.

Mr. White and Ms. Hofstadter were married in 1974 and lived in Bridgewater part-time until he

died, at which time she moved to Bridgewater full-time and became an active part of the community. Ms. Hofstadter was an avid gardener, and among other efforts put in time on the Inland Wetlands Commission.

The house that was theirs is a mid-century Modern, which is very private and sits on more than five acres of land with a reflective pond and a guesthouse.

According to Mr. Klemm, as a \$650,000 home, "This is an exciting prop-

erty that must be seen and will not last."
