Joan Rivers' home sells for \$4.4M

NEW MILFORD — The 2010 documentary “Joan Rivers: A Piece of Work” gave viewers a glimpse of the groundbreaking comedienne’s remarkably lavish lifestyle. In her house even the telephone had the shine of pure gold.

On Tuesday the sizable 10-room stone-and-clapboard structure the former talk show host called home was sold for \$4.4 million.

The property was listed by Klemm Real Estate and the buyer was represented by Sotheby’s Real Estate.

“I believe she is not coming back to this area,” said Graham Klemm, whose family owns the listing agency that has six locations.

On her Women’s Entertainment cable television reality program “Joan & Melissa,” Rivers’ said she is moving back to Los Angeles. She

spoke of how much she enjoyed Connecticut but to be closer to her daughter she is going back to the city she left in 1989.

The new owners requested anonymity, according to the Realtors involved. Documents that would list the property transfer, which are public information, were not yet available.

The original asking price for the property with 76 acres was \$4.9 million.
