Philip Roth, who died in 2018, was the noted author of more than 20 novels as well as numerous short stories. Eight of Roth's books, including *Goodbye, Columbus* and *The Human Stain*, were adapted as films. He won the Pulitzer Prize for his 1997 novel *American Pastoral*.
